Since 2012, Wood has overseen operations of this luxury boutique hotel and has the distinction of being responsible for four hotels and three restaurants that reached 5-star or 5-diamond status, and, at some locations, both.

Originally from Coventry, England, he started his career at luxury hotels in London and Paris. He forged his career in North America in the late 1970s and has held senior management positions with Four Seasons Hotels, Jack Nicklaus' Golden Bear International, Rosewood Hotels, Orient Express Hotels and Forte's Exclusive Hotels of the World. Wood has also been president and shareholder in The Garrett Hotel Group, which specialized in small, historic "Super Luxury" properties such as The Point and Lake Placid Lodge.

In 2007, Wood and two partners created Arden Grove Hospitality, dedicated to operating distinctive small luxury hotels such as Hawaii's Hotel Hana-Maui, and as owners' representative for the Rosewood San Miguel de Allende in Mexico.

Wood has also served on the boards of Relais & Châteaux North America and Preferred Hotels and Resorts Worldwide.
